2.3 Other hazards

Product with low chromate concentration as set out in Annex XVII of REACH Regulation (EC) 1907/2006.. Prerequisite for efficient reduction of the chromate concentration is proper storage and respect of the specified shelf life. Upon contact wirh water or moisture, the dry mixture will form a strongly alkaline solution. Due to its high alkalinity, wet mortar can cause skin and eye irritation. In particular, prolonged contact (e.g. when kneeling in wet mortar), may cause serious skin damage due to the alkalinity. Improper storage (exposure to moisture) or if the storage time is exceeded, action of the contained chromate reducer may decrease and sensitisation by skin contact cannot be excluded.
